Subject: Kensington Training and Employment

Procedures

The Kensington will have several employment training and hiring procedures to use. The first procedure will be during the construction phase which will last until mid 2010. The mine will begin operations in the fall of 2010.

If you want to work there for Coeur Alaska or one of their contractors or subcontractors, it will help to use the following procedures:

During construction register with Laborers Local union in Juneau at 907 586 2860 and let them know you qualify for the BBC preference because you are a Goldbelt shareholder or shareholder spouse or a shareholder descendent.

If you are a member of the Operating Engineers do the same thing with them. Their number is 907 586 3850

If you belong to another union do the same with them

Make one copy of the Coeur application but do not sign or date it. Use it as a master and make copies for every job you are interested in applying for and sign and date the copy when you send it in.

Each contractor will have a separate application but the process is the same.

If you are interested in the mining training call Colby Shibler at 907 796 6151 and he will arrange with you to attend the classes that UAS offers. They are all taught in Juneau but Coeur hires many of the people who graduate from the courses with good attendance records.

Be prepared for drug and alcohol testing. It is mandatory.
