The Alaska Native Land Claims Settlement Act (ANCSA)

was signed into law on December 18, 1971. Goldbelt, Incorporated, named after the mineral-rich corridor, represents over 3,700 Alaska Natives originating from Juneau. Through ANCSA, the Urban Native Corporation was authorized to select 23,040 acres of non-contiguous land outside the community boundaries. Through the exhaustive selection process and several land exchange agreements, Goldbelt chose lands at Echo Cove, West Douglas, and Hobart Bay for economic, as well as Shareholder access opportunities. Shareholders with a Goldbelt Shareholder ID card may access Goldbelt lands for personal, recreational, and traditional food gathering activities.
